We ensure that all parents and carers are treated with respect, dignity and courtesy. DLC will share with parents and carers any concerns we may have about their child unless doing so might place a child at risk of harm.

DLC encourages all parents and carers to disclose any concerns they may have with us. We make parents aware of our Child Protection Policy, which can be found on our website.

Information about Safeguarding is readily available and highly visible throughout the school and we have links with the local community through our Pastoral Team that promote the welfare and safeguarding of students. Staff are highly trained in dealing with safeguarding issues and understand that safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.

In line with Safer Recruitment, DLC completes enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks and seeks appropriate references before appointing staff.
